- 5 Explain how it feels to NOT understand let students experience this
- 6 Have parents bring in traditional foods from other cultures
- 7 Send home information about the benefits of bilingualism
- 8 Explore traditional clothing and items from other cultures
- 9 Create a bilingual book lending library & let students bring books home to read with parents
- 10 Throw a party to celebrate bilingualism
